ROLE PURPOSE

The primary purpose of this role is to support the Partnership team in data collection, ensuring data quality, and conducting analysis to provide actionable business insights that aid senior management in decision-making. The role serves as a key interface between the Operations, program and Resource Mobilization teams, ensuring seamless information gathering, process documentation, and validation with the Senior Management Team. Additionally, this role is responsible for implementing and supporting management information systems across multiple departments, identifying challenges and opportunities, and delivering solutions that align with the organization's strategic goals.

KEY AREAS OF ACCOUNTABILITY

- Maintain, analyze and interpret a variety of current and historic data, including data cleaning, sanity checks, missing data and draw out key findings, descriptive analysis and trend analysis.
- Provide consolidated Summaries of incomes and expenses and historical data to the LC as and when required.
- Responsible to maintain the RM Income Budget and provide regular updates to Director RM.



- Help RM director to keep a track of individual and team targets and achievements.
- Developing Strategic Quarterly presentations for the Governing Council meetings.
- Provide analysis by Income Type and Theme to the FIRM subcommittee.
- Provide updates on Budget Vs Actual by tracking the monthly/ quarterly/ half yearly/ yearly and YTD performance of CP/ IP/ IG.
- Develop RM team MIS, build team capacity on use of MIS, consolidate and share the regular reports and analysis in terms of trend, kind of donors, income projections etc.
- Monitoring of secured/ pipelines and target income and keep a close check on Variance and assess reasons for shortfalls.
- Coordinate with MIS lead in IG and help in consolidating the RM income /projection reports in alignment with IG and finance team.
- "Work Closely with Award Management team and the Finance team to ensure operational efficiency.
 Close monitoring of New Grants signing with awards, reconciling funds banked numbers with finance on a monthly, quarterly and YTD basis"
- Cash flow automation and any other financial report development as expected by the Finance Team.
- Understanding the issues in automating the Bank Reconciliation Statement in Agresso, as the team is stuck on this and trying to find a solution.
